- A <u>typed</u> essay of <u>250 words or less</u>. Handwritten essays and essays exceeding 250 words will not be accepted. You must also indicate which school you attend in the appropriate places. The applications must be received by mail or email by Monday, April 24, 2023.

Each of our Royal Oak School PTAs and the Royal Oak Schools Foundation contributes to the funding of the scholarships in honor of Donald M. Currie and Daniel Champagne, respectively. Both gentlemen were valued members and supporters of the Royal Oak Schools community. Seniors who currently attend Royal Oak public schools and will attend an accredited college, university, or trade school in the fall of the scholarship year are eligible to apply and be eligible for each scholarship. The application for the Donald M. Currie Scholarship will be judged on academics, character, extracurricular activities within school and the community, volunteer or paid work experience, and financial need. The application for the Daniel Champagne Scholarship and the Royal Oak Schools Foundation will be judged on Community Service and Charity Work, Letter of Recommendation and Academic Excellence and Academic Highlights.

The Review Committee is composed of PTA parent representatives, one from each of the Royal Oak schools who evaluate all applications received. Applicant names are hidden from the applications prior to distribution to the representatives. The Royal Oak PTA Council will award eight students a one-time \$500 scholarship in honor of Donald M. Currie. The Royal Oak Schools Foundation will award two students a one-time \$500 scholarship in honor of Daniel Champagne and four additional students a one-time \$500 scholarship to honor the work of the Royal Oak Schools Foundation.

All scholarship recipients will be announced and recognized at the Churchill High School Graduation or the Senior Convocation Program. Recipients will be notified of the award prior to receiving the award.
