

2025 Royal Oak Schools Scholarships Application

Dear Applicant:

Attached is the 2025 Royal Oak Schools Scholarships application form. Each of our Royal Oak School PTAs and the Royal Oak Schools Foundation contributes to the funding of the scholarships in honor of Donald M. Currie and Daniel Champagne, respectively. Both gentlemen were valued members and supporters of the Royal Oak Schools community. Seniors who currently attend Royal Oak public schools and will attend an accredited college, university, or trade school in the fall of the scholarship year are eligible to apply and qualify for each scholarship.

The 2025 Royal Oak Scholarship Opportunities include:

- Eight (8) one-time \$500 **Donald M. Currie Scholarships** awarded by the Royal Oak PTA Council to seniors at Royal Oak High School or Churchill Community High School (Daytime Alternative High School students only);
- Two (2) one-time \$500 **Daniel Champagne Scholarships** awarded by The Royal Oak Schools Foundation; and
- Four (4) one-time \$500 **Royal Oak Schools Foundation Scholarships**.

The application for the **Donald M. Currie Scholarship** will be judged on academics, character, extracurricular activities within the school and the community, volunteer or paid work experience, and financial need.

The application for the **Daniel Champagne Scholarship** and the **Royal Oak Schools Foundation Scholarship** will be judged on community service and charity work, letter of recommendation, and academic excellence.

In addition to your completed application, please include:

1. At least one (1) letter of recommendation from a significant adult in your life (other than a family member), discussing your character and fitness as a scholarship recipient.
2. A **typed** essay of **250 words or less**. Handwritten essays and essays exceeding 250 words will not be accepted.

Submit your application by either dropping it off at the Student Services Center or emailing it to kerry.derminer@royaloakschools.org. Please use your personal email address - do not use your rosd.org email address. The deadline for the application is **Tuesday, April 8, 2025.**

Remember that accuracy and honesty are critical in the application process. **PLEASE DO NOT WRITE** your name anywhere in the application materials except where indicated on the application and make sure your school name is entered in every field that requires it. The Review Committee who will evaluate your scholarship application includes a PTA parent representative from each Royal Oak school. Your identifying information will not be visible to the committee who reviews your application.

All scholarship recipients will be announced and recognized at the Churchill High School Graduation or the Senior Convocation Program. Recipients will be notified of the award prior to receiving the award.
